**JUDGMENT ACCORDING TO WORKS:  
NEW TESTAMENT PASSAGES**

Matthew 7:21, "Not everyone who says to Me, 'Lord, Lord,' will enter the kingdom of heaven; but he who does the will of My Father who is in heaven."

Matthew 16:27, "For the Son of Man is going to come in the glory of His Father with His angels; and will then recompense every man according to his deeds."

Matthew 25:31-46 "But when the Son of Man comes in His glory, and all the angels with Him, then He will sit on His glorious throne. And all the nations will be gathered before Him; and He will separate them from one another, as the shepherd separates the sheep from the goats" (see next vv. for evaluation based on good or bad works).

John 5:28-29, "Do not marvel at this; for an hour is coming, in which all who are in the tombs shall hear His voice, and shall come forth; those who did the good deeds to a resurrection of life, those who committed the evil deeds to a resurrection of judgment."

1 Corinthians 3:12-13, "Now if any man builds upon the foundation with gold, silver, precious stones, wood, hay, straw, each man's work will become evident; for the day will show it, because it is to be revealed with fire; and the fire itself will test the quality of each man's work."

2 Corinthians 5:10, "For we must all appear before the judgment seat of Christ, that each one may be recompensed for his deeds in the body, according to what he has done, whether good or bad."

2 Corinthians 11:15, "Therefore it is not surprising if his servants also disguise themselves as servants of righteousness; whose end shall be according to their deeds."

Ephesians 6:7-8, "With good will render service, as to the Lord, and not to men, knowing that whatever good thing each one does, this he will receive back from the Lord, whether slave or free."

2 Timothy 4:14, "Alexander the coppersmith did me much harm; the Lord will repay him according to his deeds."

1 Peter 1:17, "And if you address as Father the One who impartially judges according to each man's work, conduct yourselves in fear during the time of your stay upon earth."

Revelation 2:23, "And I will kill her children with pestilence; and all the churches will know that I am He who searches the minds and hearts; and I will give to each one of you according to your deeds."

Revelation 20:12, "And I saw the dead, the great and the small, standing before the throne, and books were opened; and another book was opened, which is the book of life; and the dead were judged from the things which were written in the books, according to their deeds."

Revelation 22:12, "Behold, I am coming quickly, and My reward is with Me, to render to every man according to what he has done."

Boice, James M. *Romans*. 4 Vols. Grand Rapids: Baker, 1991-95. Thoughtful sermons by a contemporary, Reformed expositor with a premillennial (and pro-Jewish) viewpoint.

Bruce, F. F. *The Letter of Paul to the Romans: An Introduction and Commentary*. Tyndale Series. Revised Ed. Grand Rapids: Eerdmans, 1985. Perhaps the best brief work on Romans.

Cranfield, C. E. B. *A Critical and Exegetical Commentary on the Epistle to the Romans*. 2 Vols. ICC Series. Edinburgh: T. & T. Clark, 1985. The best scholarly work on Romans, full of Greek and insight.

\_\_\_\_\_ *Romans. A Shorter Commentary*. Grand Rapids: Eerdmans, 1985. Abridged edition of the excellent work above without Greek and some technical notes.

Ellison, H. L. *The Mystery of Israel*. Grand Rapids: Eerdmans, 1966. Helpful work on Romans 9-11.

Godet, Frederic L. *Commentary on Romans*. 1883 Reprint. Grand Rapids: Kregel, 1977. A classic work.

Haldane, Robert. *Commentary on Romans*. 1853 Reprint. Grand Rapids: Kregel, 1992. Time honored comments with a recommendation by D. M. Lloyd-Jones. He saw one hundred years earlier that Israel "shall be restored to their own land" (p. 552).

Harrison, Everett F. "Romans," in *The Expositor's Bible Commentary*, Vol. 10. Grand Rapids: Zondervan, 1976. Valuable insights in a valuable commentary series.

Hendriksen, William. *Exposition of Paul's Epistle to the Romans*. Grand Rapids: Baker, 1981. Practical, independent comments from a Reformed amillennarian.

Hodge, Charles. *Commentary on the Epistle to the Romans*. 1886 Reprint. Grand Rapids: Eerdmans, 1947. A wealth of material from the great Princeton theologian.

Liddon, H. P. *Explanatory Analysis of St. Paul's Epistle to the Romans*. 1892 Reprint. Grand Rapids: Zondervan, 1961. A unique work with analytical outline and valuable comments.

Lloyd-Jones, D. Martyn. *Romans*. 9 Vols. Grand Rapids: Zondervan, 1985-91. Thought provoking sermons by a Reformed, English expositor. They flow with conviction and power.

MacArthur, John. *Romans 1-8, 9-16*. 2 Vols. Chicago: Moody, 1991,1994. Helpful sermons with practical illustrations.

McClain, Alva J. *Romans – The Gospel of God's Grace*. Winona Lake, IN: BMH Books, 1973

Moo, Douglas. *Romans 1-8*. Chicago: Moody, 1991. This will replace Murray's NIC series in 1996. Destined to become "the" commentary on Romans. Premillennial view of Israel's conversion.

Morris, Leon. *The Epistle to the Romans*. Grand Rapids: Eerdmans, 1988. Insightful and balanced comments from one who has surveyed much of the literature. One of the best works on Romans.

Murray, John. *The Epistle to the Romans*. NIC Series. Grand Rapids: Eerdmans, 1965. Helpful work from a Reformed scholar who saw a future for the nation Israel.

Sproul, Robert C. *Before the Face of God: A Daily Guide for Living from the Book of Romans*. Grand Rapids: Baker, 1992. Daily devotionals from themes in Romans.

Steele, David N. and Curtis C. Thomas. *Romans. An Interpretive Outline*. Phillipsburg, NJ: Presbyterian & Reformed, 1967. Helpful analysis with a Calvinistic slant.

Stott, John R. W. *Romans*. Downers Grove: InterVarsity, 1994. Compact comments in a readable style with excellent interpretations.

Wiersbe, Warren. *Be Right*. Wheaton: Victor Books, 1976. Good points, always with a practical slant.

Witmer, John A. "Romans," in *Bible Knowledge Commentary*. NT Edition. Wheaton: Victor Books, 1983. Excellent but brief exposition from the Dallas Seminary librarian.
